## MEDICAL FITNESS

A candidate must be medically fit to undergo the professional course applied for. The medical fitness must be certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner in the prescribed proforma, as given below:

### CERTIFICATE OF MEDICAL FITNESS

- (5) Ability to maintain erect posture,
- (6) Reasonable manual dexterity.
